# RESOLUTION OF BIG SKY RESORT AREA DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF RESORT TAX FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012

PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE BIG SKY RESORT AREA DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS UNDER SECTION 7-6-1542, MCA, AND SECTION 7-6-1547(4), MCA, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS HEREBY RESOLVES TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2011-O1R AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Big Sky Resort Area District ("District") was created effective April 7, 1998 pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. Section 7-6-1531 through 1550; and

WHEREAS, members of the District Board of Directors ("Board") have been duly elected by the electors residing within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board may appropriate and expend revenue from the resort tax collected under Mont. Code Ann. Section 7-6-1542; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to act by resolution under Mont. Code Ann. Section 7-6-1547(4); and

WHEREAS, the Board received numerous applications for receipt of resort tax funds and held a duly noticed public meeting on May 11, 2011 where questions were posed to the applicants by the Board about their applications and public comment was received on the applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board, in a duly noticed public meeting held on June 15, 2011, discussed and voted on the appropriation of resort tax funds for various resort tax applicants and public comment was received on the applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board will execute a separate agreement for the receipt of resort tax funds with each entity that was appropriated resort tax funds;

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:
